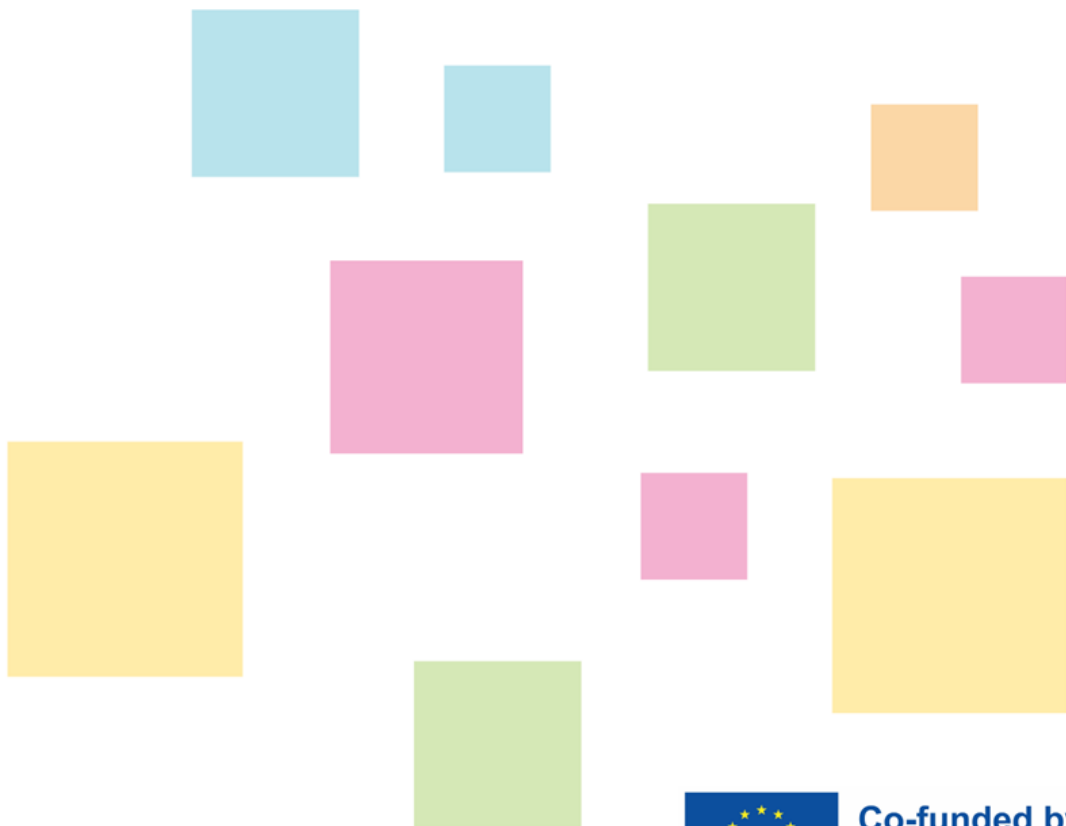

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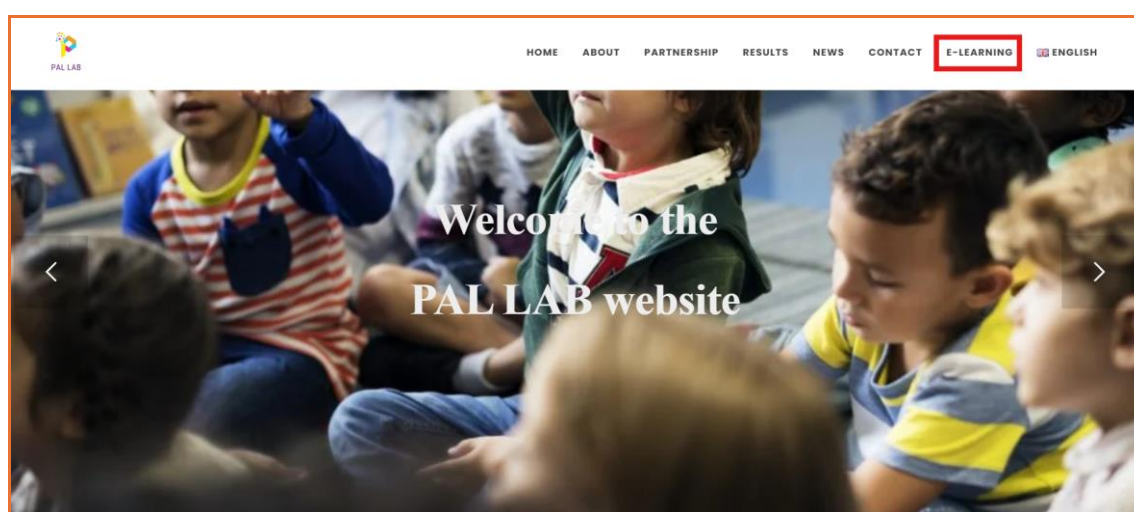

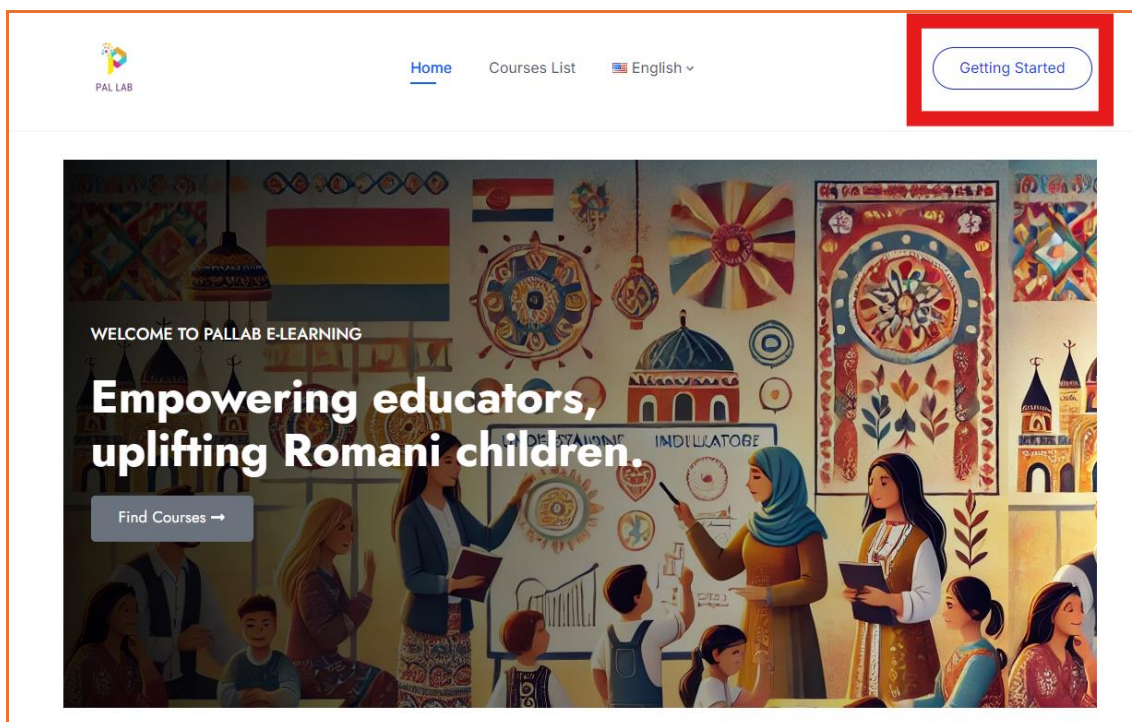
## Chapter 1: Registering the Platform


You can directly access our platform from <https://e-learning.pallabeu.com/> or from our web-site menu “E-LEARNING”.



The platform is available in 6 languages (English, Romanian, French, Turkish, Bulgarian and Greek) and it's very easy to join.

The home page of the platform welcomes us with a simple menu. Before beginning the journey, we need to register the platform. For registering we can start with “Getting Started” from the home page of the platform.

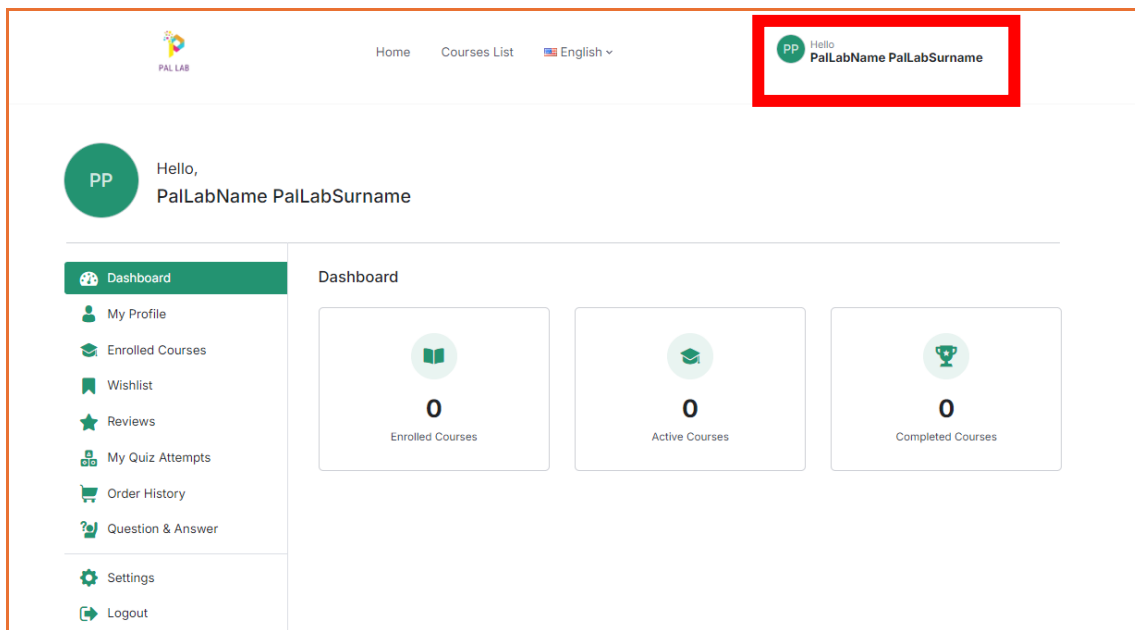

The required information for registration is basic and is not shared with third parties for any purpose. Although e-mail confirmation is not required, it is very important to write our name, surname and e-mail address correctly in order to see our progress and the details on the certificate that can be obtained at the end of the course.

We can also register with a Google account.

After the easy registration process, we are inside the platform. We can see our name on the top-right.

## Chapter 2: Modules

After completing the registration process to the platform, we can access the training content shared openly and completely free of charge.

Our platform, which consists of 5 modules and 1 quiz in total, is available in 6 different languages.

In order to join the courses that we can see from the course list, we need to enroll in each course separately.

The last step to access the course and view the contents is to click on the “Enroll Course” button.

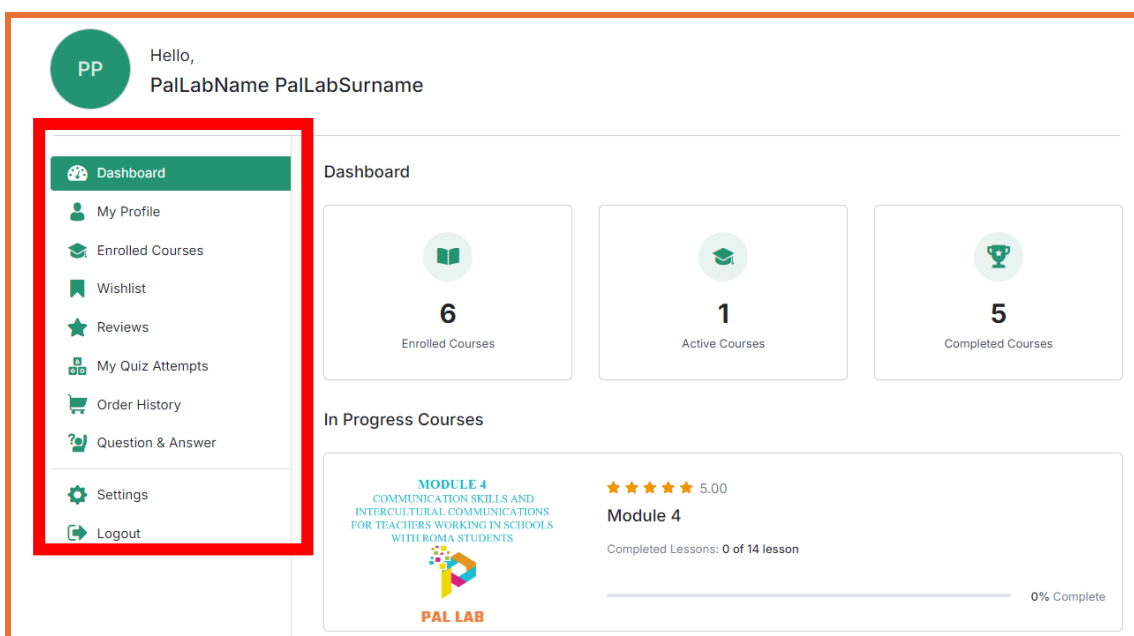
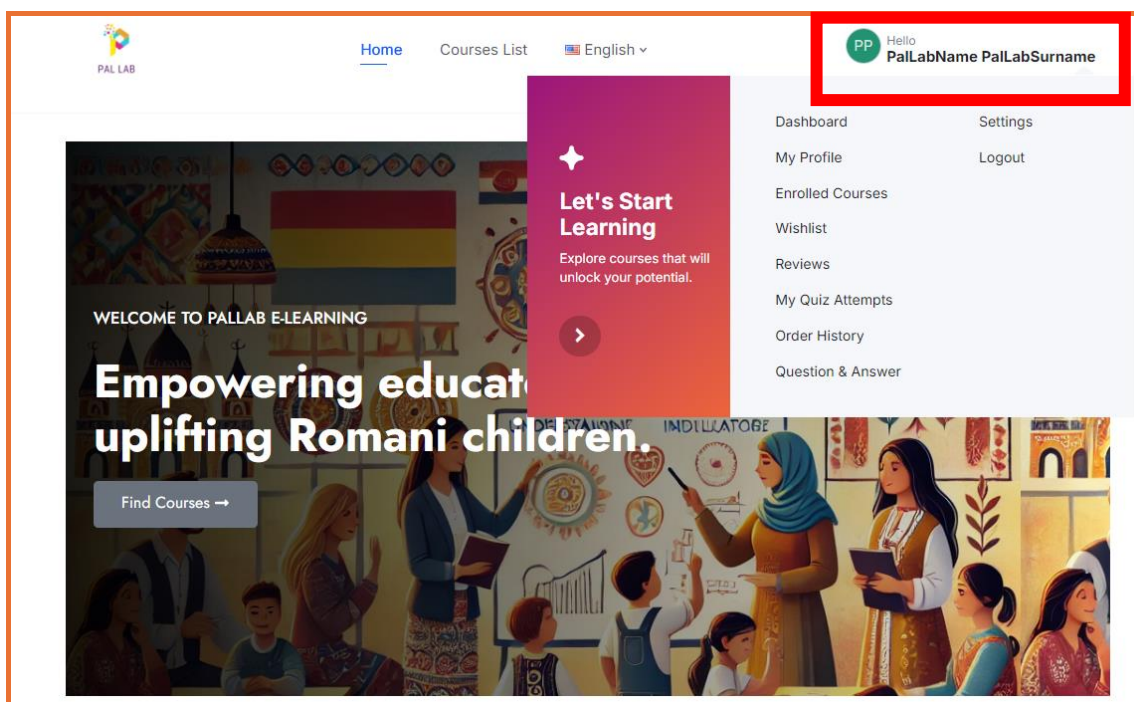
